

The Kaspar's Czech Update February 2025

It is hard to believe I have already lived in Czech for 20 years now, and the day I moved to Czech was the first day I met Lucie, so we have known each other 20 years now as well!

In 2005 it was hard to imagine how God would provide finances for the missions work, and now here we are today! You partnership and support through prayers and finances continue to make this ministry possible, and we are very thankful for you!

Mental health has quickly become an important topic in the last few years. In the Czech Republic the fourth leading cause of death among 15 to 19 year-olds is suicide. KAM (JV's partner organization in Czech) sought to address the issue through a conference called the Summit two weeks ago. Over 600 Czech Christians from 14 different denominations gathered for four days of teaching, worship, and encouragement. It was powerful to see how seriously everyone takes this topic and how motivated they are to learn more about how to help those in need.

I helped out as a volunteer at the event, and it was great to connect with youth leaders, many of whom I have known for 20 years! Lucie served as a counselor at the event, and she had many conversations with young women seeking guidance and care.

JV is giving me a sabbatical (February 24 - May 25) to be even sharper and healthier in my further life and ministry. This will be very helpful after 20 years on the mission field, and I would appreciate your prayers as this will be a new experience for me.



Romans 8:18-30

- ¹⁸ For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the glory that is to be revealed to us.
